Trinity Lutheran Code of Conduct for Athletics

Participation in athletics is a privilege and not a right. When an athlete behaves in a God-pleasing manner, (s) he earns the privilege to participate. Each by example touches the lives of everyone from teammates and coaches to the spectators in the stands.

I, _____ agree that by my actions I am an ambassador for Christ. My behavior will reflect this regardless of how anyone else tries to influence me. As a Christian athlete, I agree to the following:

1. I agree to come to practice and games on time, and with the proper attire. If I'm unable to attend, I will ask my parent(s) to provide me with a note to excuse my absence or a phone call to the athletic director or coach to inform them of my absence. (student initial here _____)

I understand that my son or daughter may receive disciplinary actions for being late, being without equipment or shoes, or having an unexcused absence.

2. I agree to the Trinity Lutheran School athletic eligibility policy as stated below:

Each student is expected to turn in homework on a daily basis.

A. If a student fails to turn in an assignment the student will be issued a warning from the teacher. The student will have until 7:30am the following morning to turn in the assignment to the athletic director along with a parent signed warning slip. The homework assignment will be expected to display satisfactory effort according to the directions of the assignment and the teacher. In the case that the homework assignment is not turned into the athletic director by 7:30am the following morning, the player will be considered ineligible for 3 school days thus obtaining their first offense. This will mean that the player will not be allowed to attend any practice or games during the 3 school day suspension.

B. If the student gets 3 warnings from teachers it will constitute one offense and the player will be suspended for 3 school days.

C. Lastly, in the situation that the student obtains 3 offenses, they will be removed from the team roster.
